REPORTS OF OFFICERS

Excel Energy: City was notified that Excel Energy has applied for a usage rate increase through the MN Public Utilities Commission.

Water Tower Inspection: Public Works Supervisor Huls asked the council if the city could have the water tower inspected this year. To have a visual inspection it would cost \$1,500 or a full inspection for \$3,500. Council Member Streich motioned to have the full inspection since that amount was budgeted and it might help the city with infrastructure grant funding. Council Member Raddatz seconded the motion, motion carried. Eye Wash Station: Council Member McGillivray motioned to purchase pull down eyewash stations for the pump house and the shop so that the City is compliant with newer OSHA standards. Council Member Clark seconded the motion, motion carried. Council Member McGillivray motioned to have a plumbed eyewash station purchased for the Fire Hall. Council Member Raddatz seconded the motion, motion carried.

Council Member Streich seconded the motion, motion carried.

Conflict of Interest Policy: Council Member Raddatz motioned to approve the Annual Conflict of Interest Policy and the 2024 Conflict of interest statements for the Mayor and Council. Council Member Streich seconded the motion, motion carried.
