The Kandiyohi City Council held their regular meeting on Monday, June 5, 2023, at the City Hall/Civic Center located at 432 Atlantic Avenue Kandiyohi, MN 56251. Present were Mayor Jon Lindstrand; Council Members Jeff Clark, Scott McGillivray, David Streich, and James Raddatz; City Maintenance, Brandon Huls; City Clerk/Treasurer, Julie Woltjer; Fire Chief Jamie Swanson.

## **CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS:**

The council asked Public Works to check into the cost and availability of spraying again.

• Close the Alley Behind the Fire Hall and Civic Center on Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup> for various KIDD Events. Council Member Clark seconded the motion, motion carried.
